



## Home Learning Policy

Home Learning is set for the following reasons:

- To reinforce learning
- To strengthen our partnership between home and school
- To provide opportunities to extend learning
- To provide opportunities to prepare for future learning
- To provide 1:1 learning opportunities
- To foster a love of learning that takes place not only in school

Homework is shared with the children and parents via letters, homework folders and on the website.

### Reading

EYFS, Year 1, Year 2, Year 3, Year 4, Year 5, Year 6	Once children are reading within our Read Write Inc. scheme, we expect them to read at least 5 times a week. Parents are asked to make a comment and sign the reading diary to acknowledge the child has read.
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### Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling

EYFS	When the child is ready, they will focus on learning initial sounds and simple words including RED words from the RWI scheme.
Year 1, Year 2	Weekly spelling lists will be sent home for the children to learn for a weekly spelling test.
Year 3, Year 4, Year 5, Year 6	Weekly lists of words from the curriculum will be sent home for the children to learn. The children will also have occasional grammar and punctuation work.

### Maths

EYFS, Year 1	Maths games at least once a half term. Times tables 10x, 5x, 2x.
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Year 2	A range of maths activities across the half term. Times tables 10x, 5x, 2x, 3x, 4x.
Year 3, Year 4, Year 5	Fortnightly activities. By the end of Year 4 we expect all children to know all their times tables up to 12x12.
Year 6	Weekly tasks linked to classroom practice.

### Topic/Writing

EYFS, Year 1, Year 2	Creative task linked to the current topic once a half term.
Year 3, Year 4, Year 5	Fortnightly tasks linked to the topic.
Year 6	Weekly tasks linked to classroom practice.

### Other Subjects

EYFS, Year 1, Year 2, Year 3, Year 4, Year 5, Year 6	Recorder or instrument of choice. Occasional Spanish. Singing/ learning scripts in preparation for concerts and productions.
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### Organisation

EYFS	Homework given will be taken home in book bags.  Homework will be collected in on the given date and feedback given according to the school policy.
Year 1, Year 2	Homework will be presented in a homework book.  Parents are asked to sign the homework book and the teacher will give feedback according to the school policy.
Year 3, Year 4, Year 5, Year 6	Homework will be presented in a homework folder.  Children are responsible for collecting their homework and returning it by the given date.  Parents are asked to sign the homework and the teacher will give feedback according to the school policy
