Safer internet day is celebrated on Tuesday 6th February with the slogan 'Create, Connect and Share Respect: A better internet starts with you' this half term we will continue to learn about internet safety and how to stay safe online. We will use the keyboard to write words and simple sentences. We will continue to use the learn-pads during class time to enhance our learning in maths, phonics and areas linked to our topic.

Science

This term we will distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made. We will identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock. We will describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials. Then compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their simple physical properties.

Art & DT

Castles are the inspiration for our artwork, we will create artefacts for our own castle and act out a variety of roles in the castle role play area. We will learn about life in a castle as we paint pictures of Arundel castle in the style of the great artist William Turner.

Humanities

This half term our topic lends itself to history. We will enjoy learning about life in the past, discovering the living conditions in a castle for both rich and poor. Our role play area will be transformed into a castle with a banqueting

English

We will continue to read from our own independent reading books and have opportunities to change these regularly in class. Maths

This term we are building on our knowledge of numbers to 50 with addition and subtraction, using number bonds, reasoning and problem solving. We will discover how to measure length accurately and use measurement for weight and volume. We have regular practise of the 10's, 2's and 5 times tables in class. However your child will be much more successful if they practise outside school too, so now is a good time to introduce regular practise into your routine.
