English




Our class reader for the term will be Varjak Paw by S.F.Said, and our guided reading will focus on this text.

RE/SMSC


RE will be learning what different people believe God is like and then Christianity the approach of Easter. In SMSC we will be looking at the effects of pollution in our International Week with our link to our other country.
